 - Rules do not apply to personal communications, using personal computers or personal time.

Provost's Report

Joe Glover, Provost

- UF has three finalists for the Dean of the College of Business. These candidates will be on campus for interviews soon.

 - o Gary McGill, Warrington College of Business, UF
 - o Steve Salbu, Wharton School, University of Pennsylvania
- The Senate had tentative assigned a homecoming date of Oct 13/14, 2017. The University selected that weekend to launch its capital campaign.
 - o New dates will need to be decided for Homecoming. Two dates are October 7th and November 18th that are available. Athletic Association prefers Nov 18th.
 - O David Quillen made a motion that this request be moved to the agenda today as an Information Item then action in February. Susan Schaffer seconded.
 - This item passed.
- Since the last Senate meeting, the Provst has received requests for further information related to FLSA salary minimums.
- <u>Postdoctoral Associates</u> Jodi Gentry, Vice President, Human Resources
 - Early 2016, US Dept of Labor announced changes to the Fair Labor Standards Act about the criteria used to determine eligibility for overtime.
 - With the new change, exempt positions below the new salary threshold would be eligible for overtime with some exceptions.
 - Student classifications such as graduate assistants and pre-doctoral fellows were not impacted.
 - After assessing the DOL impact, senior leadership decided that UF postdoctoral associates should remain exempt employees. As a result, UF announced a pay increase for existing postdoc associates beginning Dec 1, 2016.
 - o In late November, a federal court issued a nationwide injunction blocking the enforcement of the new DOL overtime rule.
 - After discussion, senior leadership decided to move forward with the increased as promised for post-docs.
 - Office of Research committed funding to assist with bridging the gap for existing postdoc associates made available as of Dec 1, 2016.
