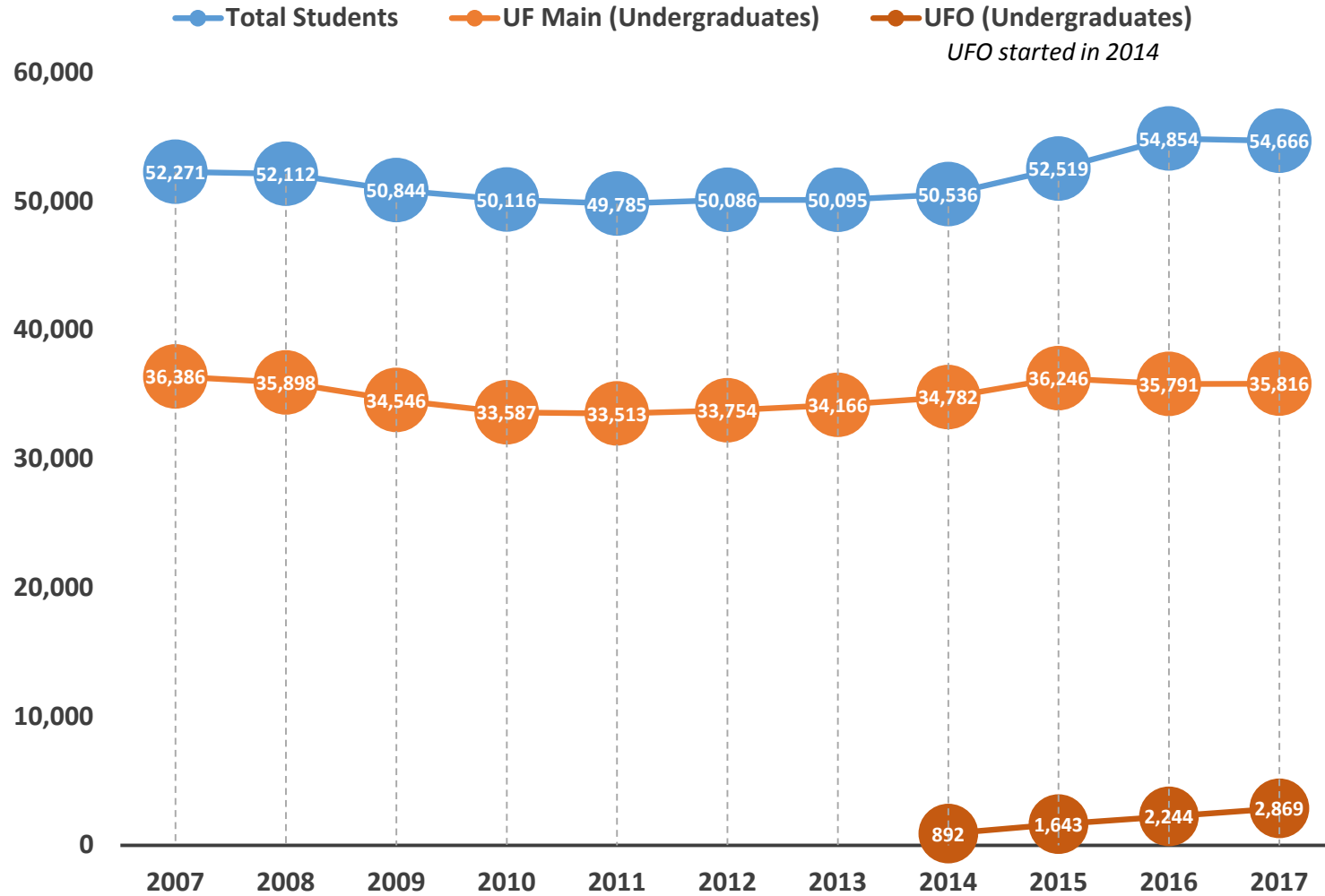

UF Enrollment

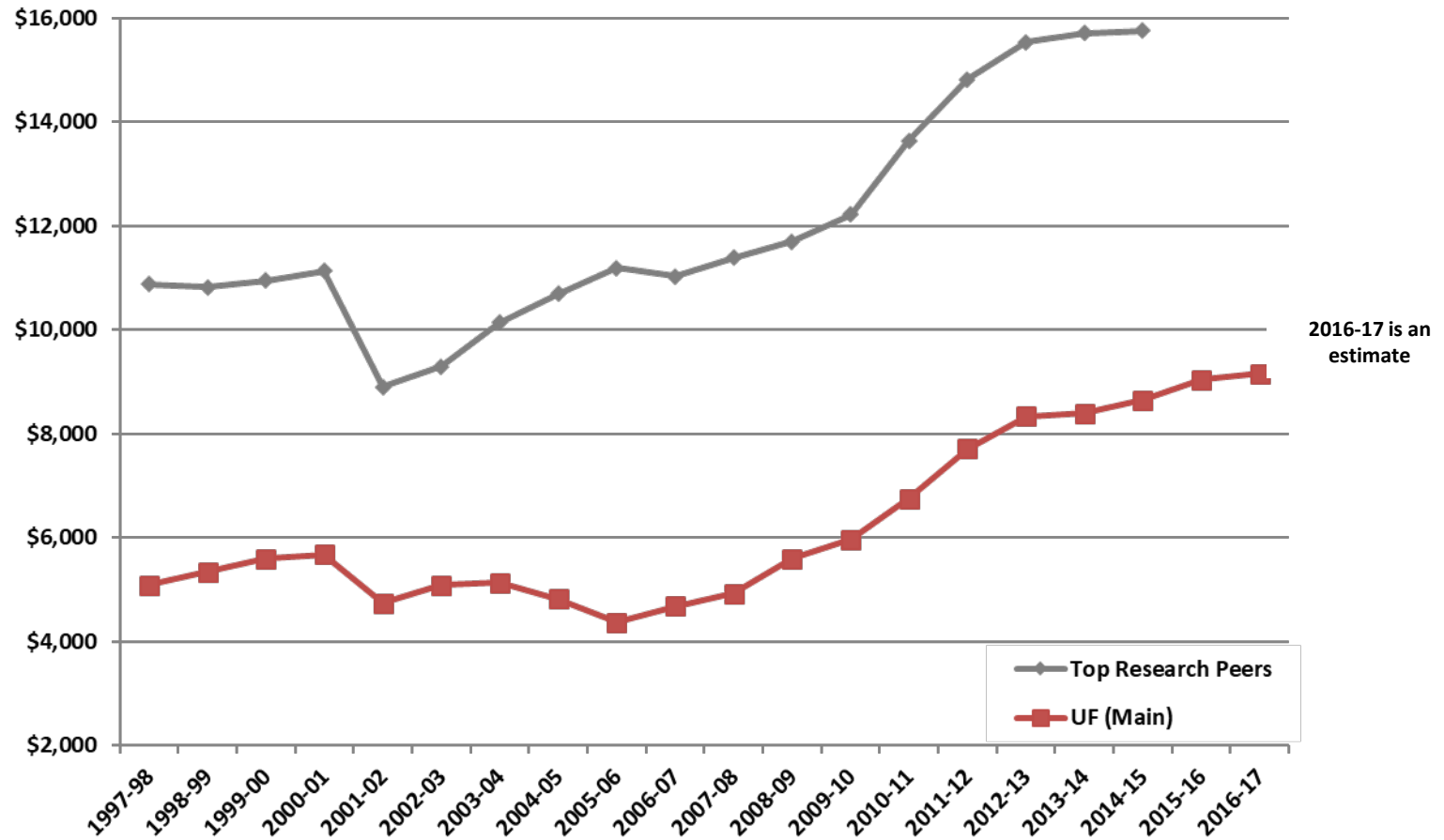

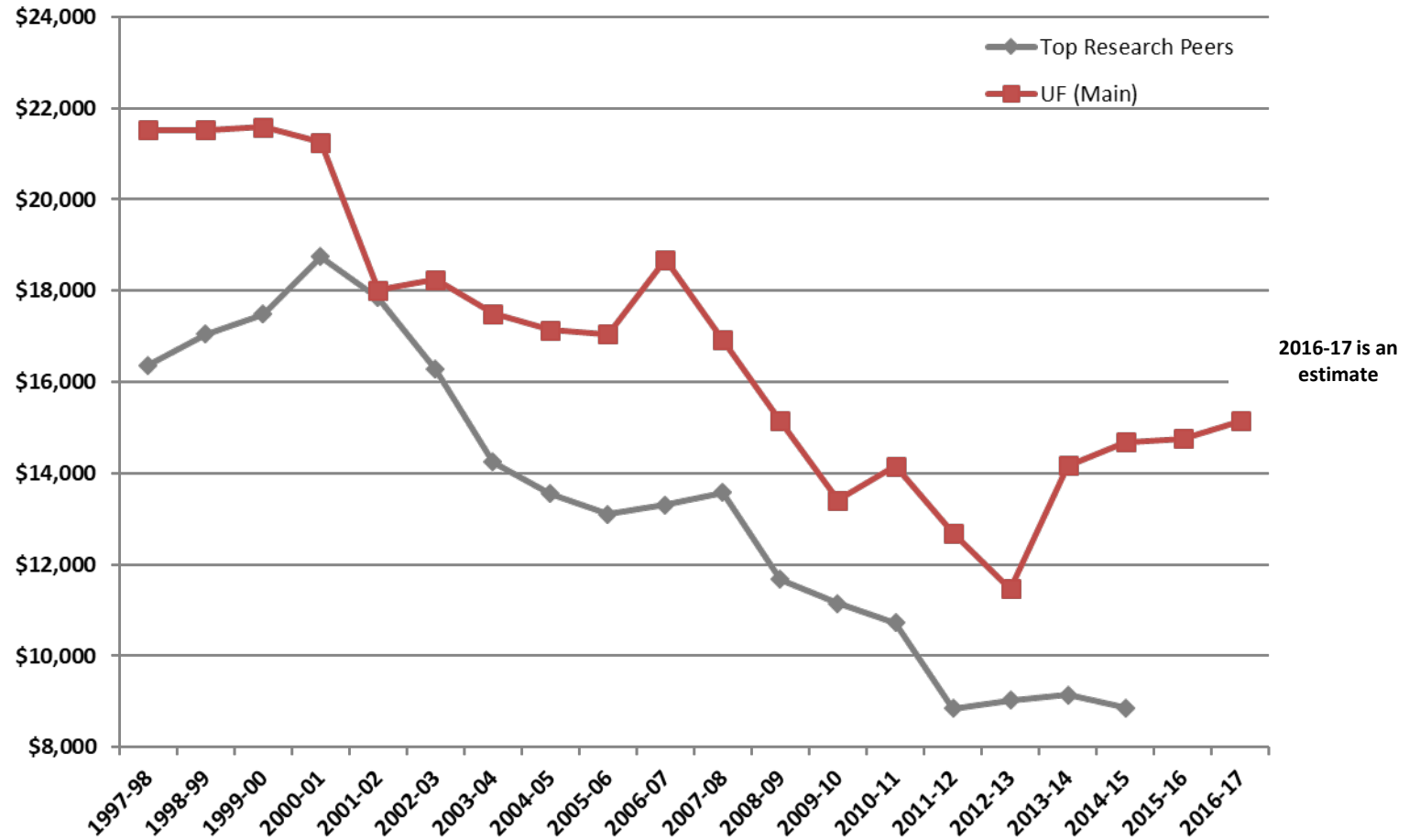
Tuition & Fee Revenue

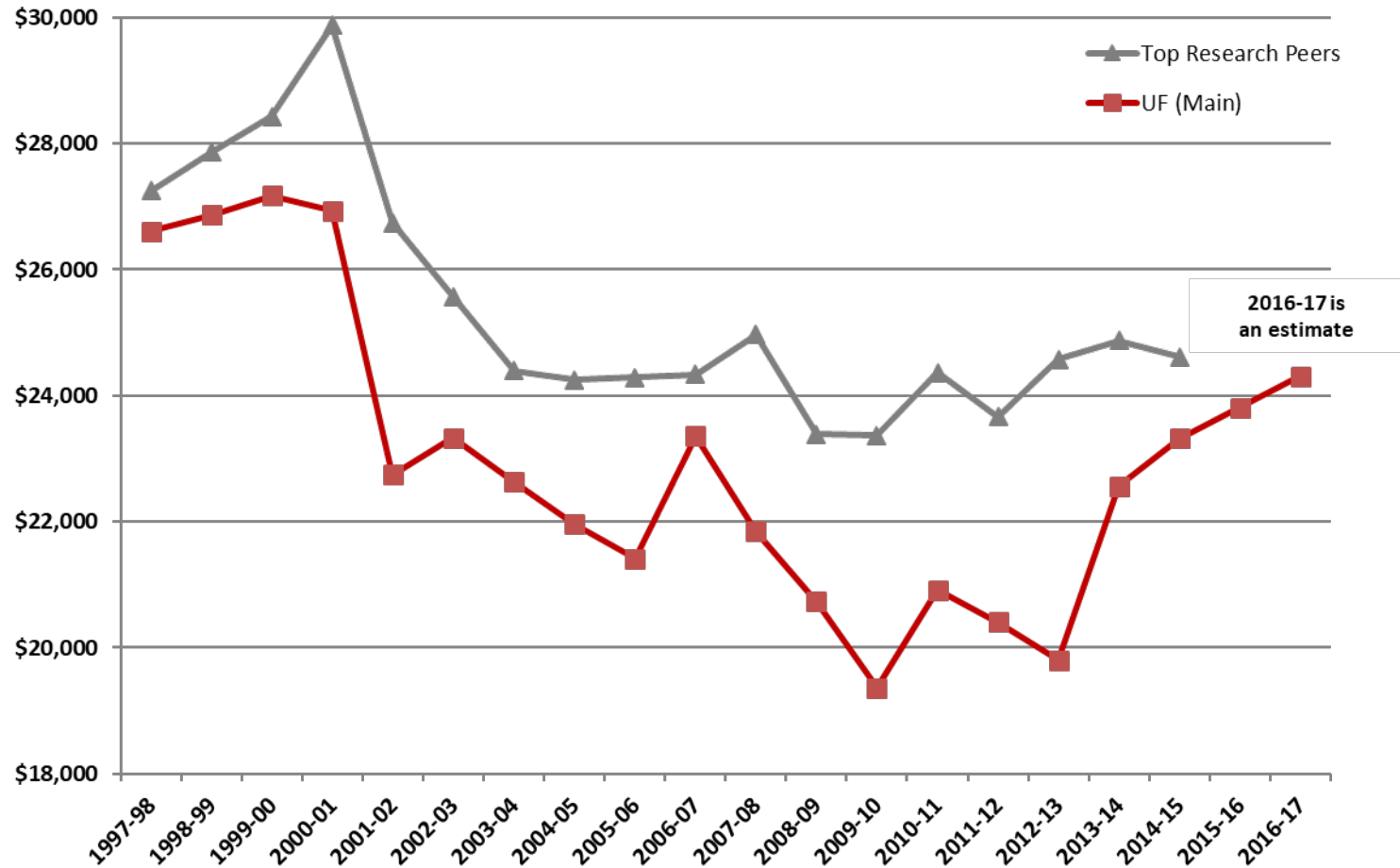
State Appropriations per FTE

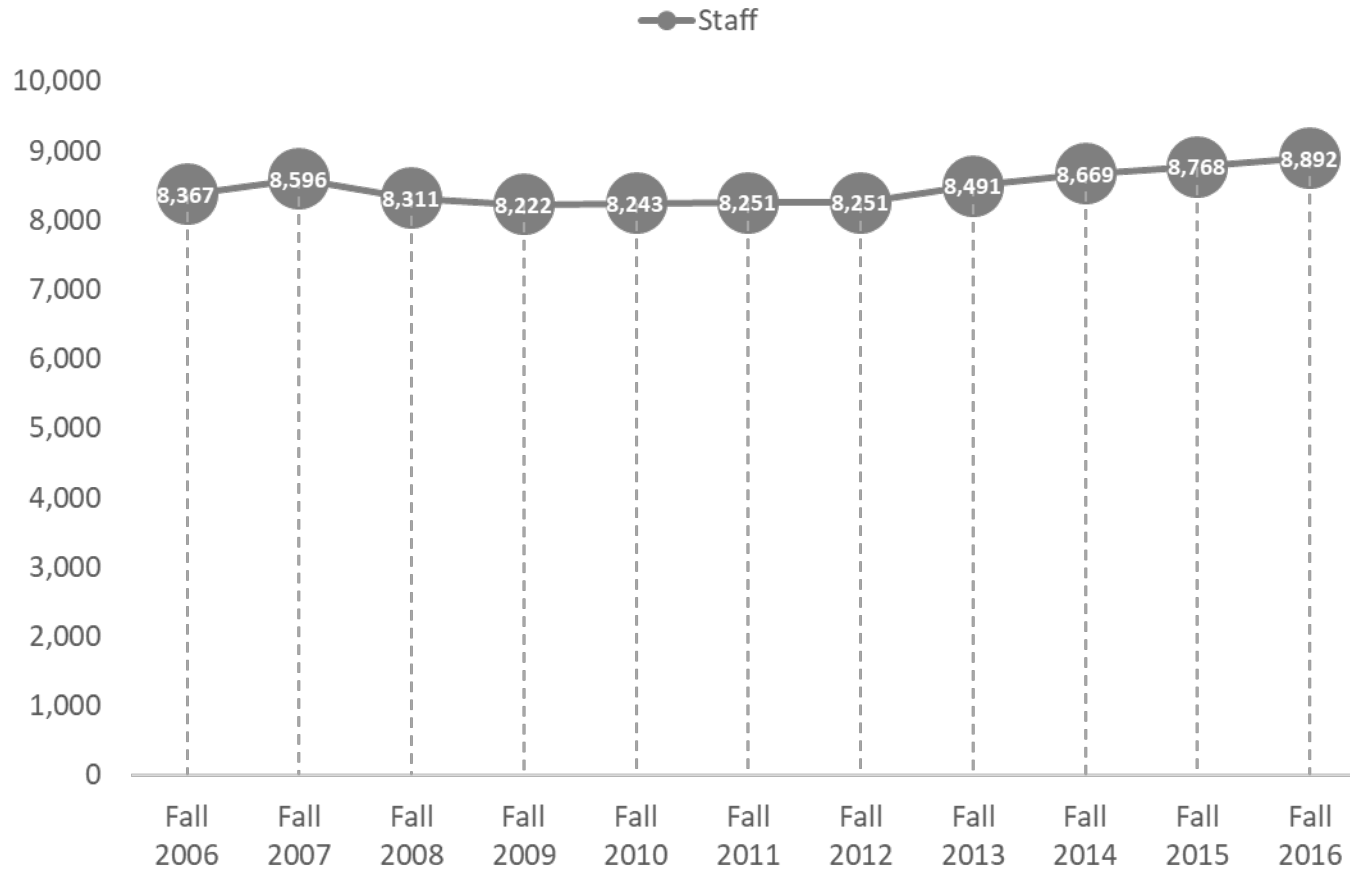
Total Revenue

per FTE



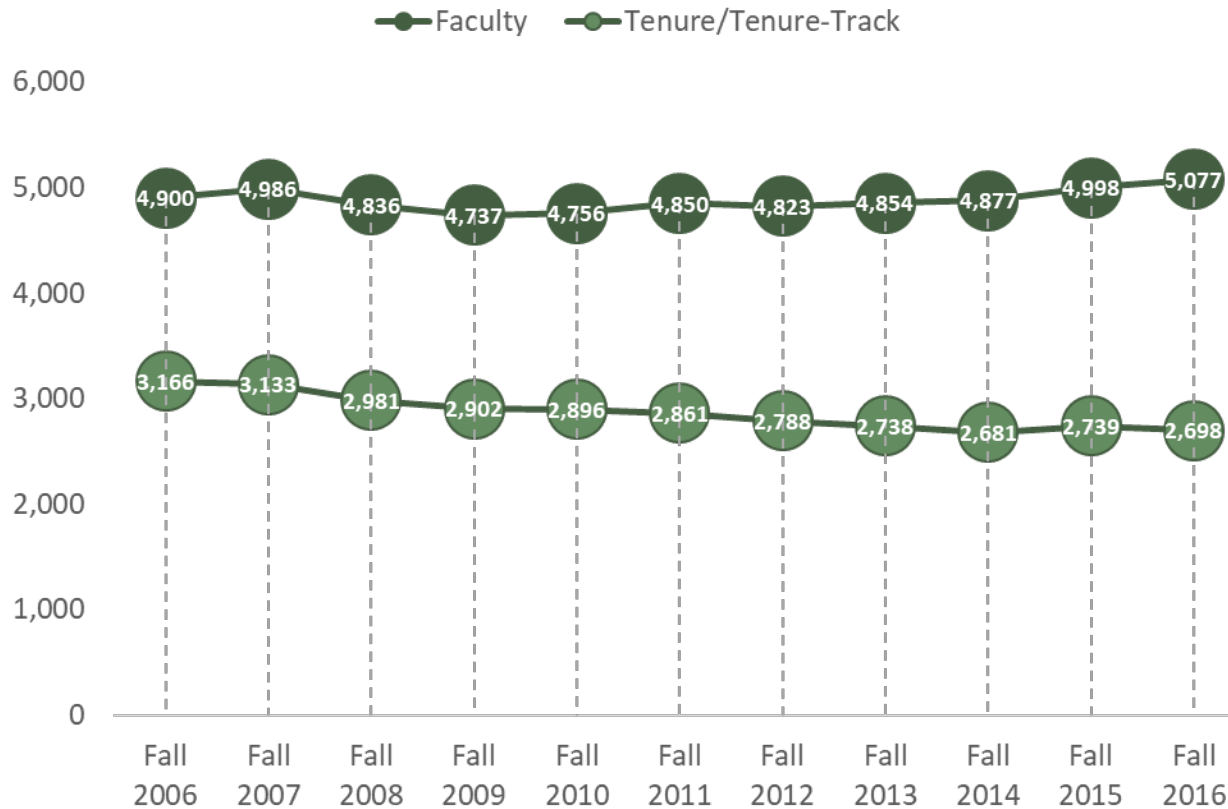
