

Constitution Committee Annual Review of Proposed University Regulation Changes

1. Committee only makes recommendation of which regulations likely need further or close consideration by faculty.
2. Committee does not interpret or rewrite; these usually start at the unit level and work way through legal.
3. Legal may be tasked to update or make a regulation reflect Federal or State regulations.
4. Recommendations are posted for comments by Faculty.

- **Green**-Changes have some impact on faculty but mainly stylistic or technical changes to regulation.
- **Yellow**-Changes have elements that concerns a limited group of faculty and the CC recommend that those faculty examine the rule changes closely and where appropriate express their views.
- **Red**-Changes have elements that many faculty members might disapprove or deem to be controversial and therefore should be given thoughtful consideration by all. Faculty examine the rule changes closely and appropriately express their views both to the Senate and administration through public website and any hearings.
 - Usually all **new** regulations are **red**.

UF-6.009	Education Centers; IFAS Committee on Tenure, Promotion and Permanent Status	Modernizes requirements to current publication and presentation methods, lists what publication may be, modernizes language, includes other activities that may be considered including grants and entrepreneurs as creative works.

UF-1.0104	UF Ethics Policy	New Regulation. Codifies conflict of interest for trustees, employees, senior administrators (P, VP, Deans, employees and officers). Names an “Ethics Advisor”
UF-4.052	Religious Observation	New Regulation. Defines that students can observe religious holidays but must provide prior notification.
<i>Misc regs</i>		
UF-1.0101	Policy for Dealing with Conduct in Research	Updates much of this to ORI-HHS guidelines and procedures. Defines time limit to filing allegation of misconduct. Defines role of legal counsel in proceedings.
UF-2.020	Food Service on Campus	Updates on catering rules, procurement. Affects how faculty and entities bring food and cook on campus.
UF-3.007	Traffic & Parking; Parking Registration	Always a red because it’s parking. New fees.
