The meeting was called to order at 11:16 a.m. minutes from October were approved with corrections.

Presidential Search Questions –

After the last meeting, Cheri sent a request to the College Faculty Council Chairs to forward an email to their faculty asking them to submit presidential interview questions on the Faculty Senate website by November 5. Today, the College Faculty Council Chairs are meeting to decide which questions will be used during three different interview opportunities. These questions will be used for 1) interviews held by the UF presidential search committee; 2) Faculty forum that will follow the selection of the final candidates and 3) Questions that Cheri can ask in her role as the faculty representative on the Board of Trustees.

To go through this decision making process efficiently, over 130 submitted questions were previously divided into different categories and numbered in a packet. This was distributed to the members prior to the meeting. Members were given no more than 6 colored dots for each category and asked to indicate their preferences by placing a dot next to a corresponding number on a flip chart. Questions that were favored were then discussed. Submitted questions were divided among the members to wordsmith.
