UF Quest Assessment Report – Fall 2021 and Fall 2022 Data

General Education Assessment Sub-committee Chair: M. David Miller

Background (from UF Quest Assessment Faculty Guide and Rubrics)

At the University of Florida, we assess UF Quest at the institutional level to determine its effectiveness at achieving the SLOs and aims of the program. The assessment data that faculty provide through the UF Quest rubrics (or other approved methods) are analyzed to determine the degree to which students are achieving the UF Quest SLOs. The results of analysis are used to determine how we can modify and improve the assessment process (e.g. procedures, criteria, measurement scales, professional development, etc.), and how we can strengthen UF Quest.

Student Learning Outcomes Assessment

The Florida Board of Governor's regulation 8.016, <u>Student Learning Outcomes Assessment</u>, requires that all undergraduate programs at the University of Florida have student learning outcomes (SLOs) in three categories: *content* (disciplinary knowledge and skills), *communication*, and *critical thinking*. The UF General Education Committee has defined these categories for UF, and the UF Quest SLOs align with these categories. The fourth category, *connection*, was added to accommodate the unique focus of UF Quest on reflection and meaning making.

UF Quest Task Force

The UF Quest Task Force, convened in 2019, developed rubrics to assess at the institutional level the various artifacts (i.e., presentations, papers, projects, performance production, reflections) that students would produce in UF Quest courses. The rubrics articulate fundamental criteria for each type of student work, with performance descriptors demonstrating progressively more sophisticated levels of attainment. Faculty assessment of the criteria provide data that inform student achievement of the UF Quest SLOs (See <u>UF Quest Assessment Faculty Guide and Rubrics</u>, p. 5).

Results

This report is the result of UF Quest assessment preliminary data analysis. UF Quest faculty worked with the Center for Instructional Technology and Training (CITT) to associate UF Quest Rubrics with existing assignments in Canvas. Instructors in UF Quest courses were expected to grade a pre-determined and random 20% student sample using the UF Quest Rubrics, and the data would be collected in Canvas *Learning Management Book*. This first data report includes results collected in Fall 2021 and Fall 2022 for UF Quest 1 & 2 courses. The following aspects must be considered in examining the data:

1. The data sets should reflect the 20% student random sample provided for each UF Quest instructor. However, some instructors chose to complete the rubrics for all students in the course section(s).


- 2. Fall 2021 data for Quest 2 reflects a pilot, so not all courses will have data included in this report.
- 3. The process needs improvements to ensure all UF Quest instructors associate UF Quest Rubrics with their existing assignments. Data summaries for both Fall 2021 and Fall 2022 show that not all UF Quest courses had rubrics associated with assignments, or rubrics were not used by all instructors in Fall 2021 and Fall 2022.

The Figure and Tables below show the results of the Quest assessment. A summary of each figure and table follows:

- Figure 1 shows the number of courses in the assessment and the percent of the Quest 1 and Quest 2 courses participating. Quest 2 shows less than 30% of the courses participating in the pilot (2021) while Quest 1 had 59-64% participating over the two years and Quest 2 had the highest participation in 2022.
- Table 1 shows that the most frequent method of assessment was writing papers (with the exception of the pilot data) and that reflection was the second most widely used method. However, reflection as method does not reflect the reflection as a course element of the courses. Apparently, faculty are sometimes collecting reflection using other methods (e.g., as part of a paper).
- Table 2 shows a high percent of the students meeting the target on all SLOs with Quest 1 higher than Quest 2. Performance is highest on the content SLOs.
- Tables 3 and 4 break down the results of Quest 2 by Social Sciences, Biological Sciences and Physical Sciences.
- Tables 5 and 6 show the results by Quest level, SLO, and criteria for Quest 1 and 2, respectively.
