Agenda Items

1. Explanation of the responsibilities of the committee – **Andy McCollough**.
2. Conversation with Student Athletes.

Andy McCollough explained that it was decided that it would be better that the UAA Committee members were not in attendance during the conversation with the Student Athletes. At this time, Jeff Guin excused himself from the room.

McCollough introduced himself and explained his role and then invited the remaining committee members and other attendees to introduce themselves.

After that, each student introduced themselves and provided a brief outline of their experience with UF.

The committee then asked a number of questions and the students responded.

After all questions were asked, McCollough advised that the committee would now move onto the other agenda items and the student athletes were welcome to stay and listen or to leave. The student athletes all chose to leave the meeting at this point.

Jeff Guin rejoined the meeting after the student athletes departed.
3. Minutes from the last regular meeting (November 14, 2022) – Approved unanimously.

4. Data Review: Academic Progress of Predictive Index Admittees and Transfer Students – **Frank Bova**

Frank Bova was unable to attend, so McCollough gave a brief overview and main points of the presentation.

5. Post-graduation outcomes for student athletes – **Mike Sagas**

Sourcing instruments to determine these outcomes. Working on 20-year cohort – hopefully have data for presentation during the May meeting.

Important data for student athletes for their futures post-graduation – including coming back after their sports career was over and graduating.

6. NIL: Update from last meeting – **Jeff Guin**

In January, Ben Chase was hired to work with all 16 sports.

Last Summer held a small Summit on NIL for the Student Athletes (SA). This summit was based on feedback gathered from prior courses. Based on the feedback received, 3 presenters were brought in: (1) Investing, (2) budgeting/saving and building credit scores, and (3) Influencer with an App. This summit was a very successful exercise with the SAs.

Going forward, will break this into 2 sessions: (1) for those SA that have no prior exposure/training in these issues and (2) to address the needs of SA who have already been introduced to the basic courses and who would benefit from more advanced subject matter.

Plans are also in place for furthering NIL opportunities and training.

It was noted that different states around the country have different rules relating to NIL, which is also a challenge.

There was a suggestion/discussion regarding the need for ALL UF students to have financial Gen Ed so they all graduate with this skill set/knowledge.
