Scott Angle, Interim Provost

- Provost Angle is attending the BOT meeting today. Chair-elect Lynne relayed the topics which Dr. Angle will provide to the Senate next week, including: post-tenure review, international hiring, and an update on the Provost's Office review.

Intercollegiate Athletics Committee (IAC) Report

Christopher Janelle, Faculty Athletics Representative

- At Senate, Dr. Janelle will review the overall role of and membership makeup the IAC; its progress under the leadership of (now retired) Dr. Andy McCollough; the IAC focus on academic-related issues; the data results from the graduated student athletes' exit interviews (which indicate a favorable UF academic experience); and recent topics of interest, ranging from Name Image Likeness (NIL) to UF student athletes' academic balance and challenges.
- Following an inquiry, Dr. Janelle addressed recent transfer portal changes and trends.

International Center for Academic Integrity (ICAI) Survey Results

John Jordi, Instructional Assessment Coordinator, Center for Teaching Excellence

- John Jordi will present to Senate the role of academic integrity in UF's partnership with the ICAI, highlighting items which have the most impact. Active resource links will be provided in his slides and the posted minutes. UF Center for Teaching Excellence resources will be shared and include alternate assessments, the resource library, syllabus statement examples, and tips for discussing academic integrity.

University Curriculum Committee

Angela Lindner, Associate Provost for

- Modify the Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP) **Undergraduate Affairs** code for the Agricultural Operations Management (AOM) Program
- This request by CALS' Agricultural Operations Management program is to create a new track in a CIP code for the existing AOM major, with a different set of common prerequisite courses (compared to those the Florida BOG currently lists.)

Graduate Council

Tom Kelleher, Graduate School

- Associate Dean for Academic Affairs - Close the MS in Animal Molecular and Cellular Biology
- This is a request to close this low enrollment program, with a phase-out occurring through Spring 2025.

Council Reports

Research and Scholarship Council

Ashley Ghiaseddin, Chair

- Dr. Ghiaseddin is traveling today but submitted this Research and Scholarship Council report: Council had a great meeting last month. The UF Health IT/Data Science team came to discuss their clinical data sharing tool for research that can be accessed by those interested in leveraging the database: Observational Medical Outcomes Partnership (OMOP). They provided a demo on how to use OMOP and future directions for the system.
- Council does not meet in December. 2021-22 Faculty Council Chair Dr. David C. Bloom has been invited for the January meeting to provide updates on the prior IRB/IACUC action item, and where we stand following Dr. Norton's updates to Faculty Senate in December.

Welfare Council

Stephanie Bogart, Chair

- Met on November 30 and will meet in January. Council is focusing on reviewing university-wide milestones to advocate for faculty and increase faculty recognition. It is also promoting collaborative faculty spaces, potentially using the Keene Faculty Center as a model.

Academic Policy Council

Nancy Clark, Chair

- APC reviewed a <u>Posthumous Recognition of Faculty Resolution</u> presented by Chair Wright and approved the resolution as amended. Chair Wright has shared it with the Provost's Office.

Budget Council

Jorg Peters, Chair

- Council followed-up on a previous McKinsey Consultants funding inquiry and confirms that they are paid via carryover funds from the President's Office. 4.7 million was spent in the summer and council will follow up to ascertain the current tally of funding to date. Chair-elect Lynne or Dr. Peters will forward this inquiry to VP Wegmann. Council also discussed College of Medicine shortfalls and ripple effects.
