Minutes

1. Committee Chair Updates
 - a. Campus Affairs, *Chris Kozak and Kimone Simmons*
 - a. *No updates on Campus Affairs but Housing and Res Life are posting for RA recruitment*
 - b. Communications, *Emily Overend*
 - a. No updates
 - c. Professional Development, *Dylan King*
 - a. Proposal deadline has passed and submissions under review.
 - b. Conference planning is coming along – registration email to be sent by Friday, 1/21. Website link to registration will be available then, too.
 - c. Conference will be run through Canvas platform like last year
 - d. Chair, *Dylan King*
 - a. Student Success Summit (for those involved) will be held February 12th online
 - b. UF Day of Gratitude to be held 2/9. Class will be held, but events of the day have not yet been made clear
 - c. Civic literacy exam offered by UF can continue as it has over the past few semesters (no external proctoring will be required)
 - d. If you have out of state equivalency for AMH2020/POS2041, they can be eval'd to determine if applicable toward civic literacy requirement
 - e. Academic Affairs working on transfer student experience – pushing for timely graduation standard to change from 2yrs to 3yrs
 - f. Reminder: if a student tests positive for COVID-19 they should report test results to the DOH. Current messaging on Student Health Center webpage is being re-worded.
2. Quest Reminders, *Toby Shorey*
 - a. For IA students, Q1 & Q2 met by the IA minor
 - a. It is possible that more areas of Quest will be met by the minor as they roll out, but it is till TBD
 - b. Reverse Articulation of AA – if a student earns 30 credits or more at a FL state college system school, they must be allowed to transfer courses from UF back to that institution to complete their AA

- a. Eligible students will get an email informing them of this possibility and will ask them to indicate whether or not they'd like UF to send this info back to the institution to be evaluated. UF does not guarantee that the other institution will award the AA, just that the info will be sent for evaluation
 - b. There will be a one.uf checklist where students can see they qualify and students must respond that they want UF to send if information to their previous institution by 2/12
 - c. Aa.ufl.edu webpage has more details
 - d. Outreach will go out to freshmen and transfer students (those who didn't complete the high school AA, etc.)
 - e. Toby will send out an email with details on the communications and the checklist
 - f. Currently 1250 students are eligible; they only receive one notification of this opportunity. Next semester, the number is expected to be closer to 100 notifications.
 - g. Unclear if this will waive summer requirement if awarded
 - h. Students won't be eligible for the AA at UF and at their former institution
 - i. This is not a way around Quest requirements
 - j. UFLonline students are included in this opportunity
 - k. Students do not have to pay for this transcript to be sent and it is flagged for the receiving institution as an evaluation for Reverse Articulation of the AA. UF will be notified if that institution decides to certify the AA.
- c. Civic Literacy – students will now be offered a Civic Literacy exam in high school that could apply toward requirement. It is unclear how UF will be notified if they passed/if the requirement is met
 - d. There is a flag on electronic transcripts that lets people know if general education has been met and UF will now be utilizing it (as it is now required)

3. C3 Update Allie Simon

- a. Survey that was sent out was lengthy, but not all of the info will be shared in the canvas site – looking for patterns and ways to synthesize
- b. Won't be one size fits all; will just provide links to college/dept level advising
- c. If you want to work w/ Allie to provide some more info and feedback on what she has built in the module, contact her
- d. There are concerns regarding working professionals who are non-traditional – can there be some kind of mastery level opt out on different paths through it? Something to consider
- e. The survey can be resent if you didn't participate initially
- f. Any other questions, send through Dylan or to Allie
