


## Proof of Concept: Additional syllabus link in Canvas course navigation

This is a proof of concept to add Canvas course-level navigation for required/common UF policies and campus resources to supplement the course syllabus. This would allow updates to be pushed out to courses and have the new information reflected in this new link. The name of the link and the content still need to be determined. This could be executed for the Fall 2023 semester.


### Example of the new syllabus policy and resource link:

The new link can be inserted in the course left navigation menu and be positioned right after the "Syllabus" link. The naming of the link is not finalized.

## In-Class Recording

Students are allowed to record video or audio of class lectures. However, the purposes for purposes are

- (1) for personal educational use,
- (2) in connection with a complaint to the university, or
- (3) as evidence in, or in preparation for, a criminal or civil proceeding. All other purposes require the written consent of the instructor. A "class lecture" is an educational presentation in any instructor-led discussions that form part of the presentation, and delivered by any in University of Florida course. A class lecture does not include lab sessions, student presentations involving solely student participation, assessments (quizzes, tests, exams), field trips, presentations by faculty or guest lecturer during a class session. Publication without permission of the instructor or provide access to a recording, regardless of format or medium, to another person (or posting to a social media section. Additionally, a recording, or transcript of a recording, is considered published if but not limited to social media, book, magazine, newspaper, leaflet, or third party note/tutoring session be subject to a civil cause of action instituted by a person injured by the publication and/or Conduct Code.
