



A College of Firsts

- The first health college at UF (1923)
- The first college at UF to offer a Ph.D. (1930)
- Jeanette Radin Byers becomes the first female graduate with a master's degree from UF (1932)
- The women students in the college organized a society called the Spatula Club becoming the first woman's organization on the campus of the University of Florida (1936)
- Ira C. Robinson was the first African American to graduate from the College of Pharmacy and the Ph.D. graduate of UF (1966).
