Summer and Fall 03 Preview material described THE2000 as having GenEd "I" credit in error. Steve Pritz proposed first year students enrolled in THE2000 either Summer 03 or Fall 03 will receive I credit. The Preview material has been corrected.

According to the 2004-2005 Undergraduate Catalog, the criteria for admission to the College of Public Health and Health Professions for UF Juniors and Seniors, includes "completed all writing, math and foreign language requirements" (page 3-257).

During the Fall 03 term, 1611 students received Writing Requirement Credit for 2668 AP exams that do not have corresponding WR university courses.
