The proposed I/D requirement, "Three credits of course work must have an international focus and three credits of course work must have a diversity focus. Courses in this category will always fulfill another Gen Ed category as well" was approved by the Council.

The proposed minimum grade requirement, "Students must earn a grade of C or higher in courses taken to fulfill General Education requirements" was approved by the Council.

The Council supports requiring the syllabus of each General Education approved course to include a statement defining the general education purpose of the course.
