



Faculty Town Hall: Spring 2021 Face to Face Classes – October 6, 2020 @ 1:30 p.m.

On Tuesday, October 6, at 1:30 p.m., the [Faculty Senate](#) is hosting a virtual town hall to discuss the university's move to a more robust set of face-to-face offerings in the Spring 2021 semester. The scheduling process is underway in your Colleges and Departments. It is motivated by at least three considerations: (1) to better serve a cohort of students who want and need face-to-face opportunities for instruction, consistent with CDC guidelines for classrooms; (2) to reinforce the university's commitment to the goals of the State University System of Florida (SUS) and the State; and (3) to initiate a return to a more normal state of operation and engagement in all aspects of the UF enterprise.
